DISTRICTS

A. DISTRICTS

1. TS recognizes six administrative districts: Northeastern, Eastern, Southeastern, Central, Middle, and Western.
2. Each District has the responsibility to administer the programs and policies of TS.
3. A map and listing of the counties in each district are shown below.
4. Geographical boundaries may be modified or new districts created by the Board of Directors to serve the best interests of the membership and development of the sport.

B. DISTRICT OFFICERS

1. Each District Director shall be elected by the affiliated membership in each respective district.
2. The membership of each district may elect other district officers as defined in their respective district rules.
3. The District Director shall serve as the district representative on the TS Board of Directors.
4. As a member of the Board of Directors, the District Director shall fulfill the duties outlined for the position in the TS Constitution, Bylaws, Policies, and Procedures.
5. The District Director is delegated administrative jurisdiction within the district, except for certain administrative authority that may be preempted by the governing documents of TS, by the Board of Directors or Executive Committee.
6. The District Director may appoint program administrators to assist in the administration of TS programs, events, and activities.
7. The District Director shall appoint representatives to serve on TS committees as required by the TS rules or when requested by the Board of Directors.
8. A current directory of all district officers and administrators shall be kept on file in the State Office.

C. DISTRICT RULES

1. Notice of district meetings must be sent to member associations and the State Office at least 14 days in advance of the meeting.
2. The district may adopt rules, policies, and guidelines to aid in serving the needs of the district membership.
3. Copies of such rules shall be kept on file in the State Office.

D. DISTRICT FINANCES

1. All district finances shall be managed by the TS State Office.
2. An annual budget shall be submitted by each District Director for approval by the TS Board of Directors.
3. The district may assess fees or use other methods of raising funds for use in district events, activities, and programs.
