

BYLAW VI. AMENDMENTS

A. APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS

1. Amendments to the Constitution and Bylaws must be approved by two-thirds of the voting members at a general membership meeting.

2. Members and directors may vote by proxy.

B. AMENDMENT PROPOSALS

1. Proposed amendments may be submitted by any district, affiliated member association, an officer of TS or its districts, or by a member or officer of an affiliated member association.

2. Proposals should include the number and text of the current rule, the text of the proposed new or revised rule, and the reason for the change.

3. Proposals to revise or amend the Constitution and Bylaws shall be submitted in writing to the State Office at least 60 days in advance of the general meeting.

4. Amendment proposals shall be published and distributed to affiliated members for study at least 30 days prior to the general meeting at which the proposal will be considered.
